“D’Souza’s Mules Left Tracks”, by Charlie Johnston, 6.20.2022



[There are] seven blessings that we have come across as we have gone through this book.

- *Blessed is he who reads and those who hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written in it; for the time is near (1:3).*
- *“Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on.” “Yes,” says the Spirit, “that they may rest from their labors, and their works follow them” (14:13).*
- *Blessed is he who watches, . . . (16:15).*
- *Blessed are those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb! (19:9).*
- *Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first resurrection. Over such the second death has no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with Him a thousand years (20:6).*
- *Blessed is he who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book (22:7).*
- *Blessed are those who do His command-*

*ments, that they may have the right to the tree of life, and may enter through the gates into the city (22:14).*

. . . the Bright and Morning Star shines through the dark night of wrath. Jesus Christ is our hope, our joy, our peace, our salvation!

*And the Spirit and the bride say, “Come!” And let him who hears say, “Come!” And let him who thirsts come. Whoever desires, let him take the water of life freely (Revelation 22:17).* These words are packed with passion. Sometimes I hear preachers read these words in the biblical monotone that is used in so many religious services. I want to jump up and ask, “Do you realize what you are reading?”

One last time, our loving Bridegroom reminds us that He’s coming for us: *He who testifies to these things says, “Surely I am coming quickly” (Revelation 22:20).* If you ever have wanted to see the heart of Jesus Christ, just look at His threefold reminder in this chapter that it won’t be long until we see Him. Any time we doubt, any time we want to cry out, “How long, O Lord?” we just need to remember these words.

Thus, when Jesus tells us that He is coming quickly, we echo the closing words of John’s letter and use them to conclude this book: *Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus! The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen (verses 20–21).*

I don’t know if this gives you a lift, but it certainly does to me! I am so horrified by what we must watch in our society all around us that some days, I can hardly stand it. More and more we shout, “Come quickly, Lord Jesus!” And one of these days, He will! Will you choose this glorious future by committing your life to Him?


