"Advent is a time for marveling at inner mysteries, a time for watching in awed silence, and a time for getting in touch with our deepest longings for the Lord. Silencing the externals and going deeper into the stillness allows you to taste the riches of the incarnation. And what appears to be deprivation creates an expectation and space in one's soul

to contain more Christmas joy when the 24th of

December arrives."
I like that.

While we can't all physically find a place apart from our busy lives, I pray that we find time in our hearts and minds to anticipate with excitement and expectation what God will do in our lives in the next few weeks.

I pray we can strip down mentally to the essentials and find comfort and peace in knowing God loves us.
