Exodus was the first of several things He showed me, and in the years since, I have found that it is an accurate account of the events leading to the founding of the modern state of Israel on May 14, 1948, and told a story every bit as exciting and filled with miracles as that of the United States.

This began my intense interest in Israel. Not Jewishness. Not their headless religion, missing the boat of their own Messiah, Jesus. Just modern Israel, the miracle that happened in 1948. In Benjamin Netanyahu, the Prime Minister with the funny name that I have admired since the first day I heard of him.
